Note by the secretariats

1. Set out in the annex to the present note is a list of States, political and economic integration organizations and regional economic integration organizations that are parties to the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions as at 22 February 2010, the date of the opening of the simultaneous extraordinary meetings of the conferences of the parties thereto.
2. As indicated in paragraph 2 of Article 25 of the Basel Convention, “for each State or political and/or economic integration organization which ratifies, accepts, approves or formally confirms this Convention or accedes thereto after the date of the deposit of the twentieth instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval, formal confirmation or accession, it shall enter into force on the ninetieth day after the date of deposit by such State or political and/or economic integration organization of its instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval, formal confirmation or accession”.

3. Likewise, paragraph 2 of Article 26 of the Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions indicates that “for each State or regional economic integration organization that ratifies, accepts or approves this Convention or accedes thereto after the deposit of the fiftieth instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession, the Convention shall enter into force on the ninetieth day after the date of deposit by such State or regional economic integration organization of its instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession”.
